We would like to create a password protected area on the website in which we can upload detailed resources on treatment options and clinical trials. We believe that this information will help healthcare providers to make informed decisions about treatment options in the area of atrial fibrillation. In order to complete this project effectively we would plan to work with a digital agency to help us create the necessary technology to have a password protected area on the site. We would require a system which would allow us to vet potential registrants to make sure that they are healthcare professionals before we approve their access to this section of the site. We will also use the registration process to offer the opportunity for applicants to receive further updates from the AFA, and to strengthen our relationship with the professional community. Once this area of the site has been created we would plan to promote the new resources at leading medical conferences and events to ensure that we get the maximum value out of the project. This would also allow us to collect feedback which we could use to evaluate our materials. Further to the evaluation feedback we receive, the 10k grant would also allow us to work with a leading expert to ensure that our materials are kept up to date for the duration of two years. We are committed to continuing to provide up to date and informative resources for healthcare providers working in the area of Atrial Fibrillation.
