Creation of Mobile Information and Prevention Unit (vehicle type Van) for the attainment of informative visits all around Greece. Making informative speeches and distribution of informative leaflets about atrial fibrillation. Performing free of charge electrocardiograms during the visits.

Creation and operation of Mobile Information Unit for Atrial Fibrillation. The non-profitable organization "Life Line" according to its program 1 mission 1 million, will focus the social action in the whole Greece and especially in the border areas (Pomakoxoria, Samothraki, Kastelorizo etc). The goal is to visit 240 centers of daily care of elderly (KAPI & KIFI) (ie at least 12.000 elderly) throughout a year and make free of charge, electrocardiograms at each visit. During these visits would be done speeches on atrial fibrillation and distribution of informative leaflets. For the achievement of these goals of the program and considering the geographical distribution of this country, the program would be activated as follows: Border areas: Visit border areas for a 3 days period because of the long distance from the capital and of the distance between the villages, it is needed more time. It is suggested mission 1 week x 3 times a year. 7 days x 3 visits = 21 days North and Central Greece – Peloponnese Visit cities, counties and villages with a period of 3 or 4 days for each mission, throughout the year. 3 days x 20 visits = 60 days Islands Visits of the mobile information unit during spring and autumn. Missions' duration 3-4 days. 4 days x 8 visits = 32 days Attica Daily visits in centers of the daily care of the elderly (KAPI, KIFI) in Attica throughout the year. 1 day x 44 times = 44 visits
