In order to achieve early detection of atrial fibrillation, authorization must be obtained from the relevant authorities for interinstitutional links among the various health centers and for the care of elderly patients

The relevant authorities must give their consent. Teams of 2 students in the tenth quarter of their university medical studies will be formed, supported by 2 nurses in the last quarter of their studies. They will visit health institutions, kindergartens, shelters, emergency rooms and intensive therapy units, where these patients will be detected. Patients will undergo a general clinical evaluation and have their heart rate and blood pressure checked, electrocardiographical records assessed and receive information on the risks of arrhythmia, and be sensitized to giving it the proper monitoring and attention.
